### Out of Outbreak

I am pleased to report that all COVID-19 tests of residents and staff conducted after the initial case have come back and all are negative (*clear of COVID-19*). **We are now officially out of outbreak.** The only positive case was identified in an employee who has not worked in the past month. That case is considered to have been community-acquired (versus being contracted in the Home). The individual is recovering nicely at home.

I want to thank staff for their vigilance during this period, and for their dedication as they continued to come to work to provide care and services to our residents. The fact that further cases were not identified suggests that our infection prevention protocols have been effective. That said, we will continue to be on our guard to avoid potential future infections.

I want to thank residents and their loved ones for their patience, understanding, and cooperation during the outbreak period. As we all look forward to the Ontario government easing restrictions on all long-term care homes, I would like to kindly remind people that they are still in place and that our primary focus throughout this pandemic is the health and well-being of our residents and staff.
