To: All Residents, Families, and Staff

Outbreak Declared – Harvest Home Area Only

This note is to advise you that we have been deemed in a COVID-19 Outbreak at the direction of Public Health. One resident and one staff member in our “Harvest” Home Area have tested positive for COVID-19. We have just delivered tests from all the residents in the affected home area to the lab and now we await the results.

The affected resident has been isolated for several days already, so Public Health considers the exposure to be low-risk. We continue to monitor residents and staff for signs and symptoms of the virus as directed by Public Health.

All residents in Harvest are being asked to remain in their rooms and group activities have been cancelled there. Of course all visits and absences have been cancelled in the Harvest home area. One designated Essential Caregiver Visitor can continue to visit, per resident, in Harvest during this Outbreak. Visiting and absences are unaffected in the rest of the Home.

Virtually 100% of our residents have received four COVID vaccinations, which appear to provide excellent protection against this virus. Our staff are all fully vaccinated.

While the vaccine may not prevent the transmission of COVID, it has proven to be very effective at reducing serious illness and hospitalizations – especially among those with third (and fourth) doses. *If you are eligible for a booster, we strongly recommend that you get it as soon as you can.*

We will keep you updated as the situation changes.
