Outbreak Update

The preliminary positive cases at Centennial Place that we reported previously have been confirmed through lab-based PCR tests. There are now eight total resident cases, all in the same area of the Home. The affected residents continue to have mild symptoms at this time. Outbreak protocols continue to be in effect, with positive residents relocated to a designated cohorting zone.

We continue to monitor residents and staff for signs and symptoms of the virus as directed by Public Health. All residents remain in their rooms and all visits and absences continue to be cancelled (per provincial directives). As a reminder, virtually all of our residents are fully-vaccinated and have also received the booster shot. As communicated previously, the third shot/"booster" appears to provide excellent protection against the Omicron variant.

There have been no issues with staffing levels and, in fact, extra staff have been deployed. All staff are fully vaccinated, and most have had their boosters.

We will keep you updated as circumstances dictate.
