Moira Place Update

I am pleased to report that the precautionary restrictions have been removed from Moira Place. The affected residents all tested negative and the Hawthorn and Mulberry home areas returned to normal in the middle of last week.

With outbreaks currently in more than half of the long-term care homes in Ontario, we remain vigilant. We continue to surveillance test all persons entering the Home and remind you that if you are not feeling well or have been a close contact of someone with COVID that you do not visit. As a further reminder, all general visits and absences have been cancelled as per provincial directives.

Essential Caregiver visitors can continue to visit residents, with a maximum of two (2) designated essential caregivers per resident. Essential Caregivers are reminded that, they must be fully vaccinated by February 21, 2022, and must have their booster dose by March 14, 2022 in order to enter the premises.

All of our residents have received a vaccine booster” (third dose) and, by policy and regulation, all staff are “fully vaccinated”. In addition, I am pleased to report that virtually all residents have had their fourth doses of the vaccine, and our staff will soon have received their third shot “boosters”.

Finally, I can’t emphasize this enough: If you are eligible, *please get your booster shot (third dose) as soon as you can.* The vaccine works.
