Moira Place in Outbreak Protocols

We have had a resident who resides in our Trillium home area test positive for Covid-19 and Public Health has asked us to put this home area into outbreak. The test was done on February 24th and we've taken steps to isolate the affected residents in Trillium once we had the test results.

The testing was done as a proactive measure, as we have had a small number of staff either test positive or become high-risk close contacts of people in the community who were positive for Covid over the past month. This is the first instance of a resident testing positive for the virus.

Currently Trillium is the only affected home area; however, that could change with further testing and we will let you know if that is the case.

Essential caregiver visitors can still visit all residents in Trillium and Public Health is limiting this to one visitor at a time, with additional PPE. Those residents in isolation can have one essential caregiver visitor as well and those visitors must wear full PPE. Visits in the rest of the home can continue as usual per the latest Ministry of LTC / Chief Medical Officer of Health guidelines.

Unaffected residents can continue with communal dining in our dining room and join in on small group activities.

We have contacted each substitute decision maker for each resident in Trillium and wanted to share this information with you as well.

Our staff are cohorted to this home area and we continue with our enhanced precautions to help prevent the spread of this virus. We perform rapid antigen tests on every person coming into the home each day, including all staff, support workers, volunteers and visitors. Enhanced monitoring of symptoms is now being done for all residents in Trillium.

All eligible residents have received their 4th shot of a Covid vaccine, which should provide additional protection against this disease.
