Princess Gardens Outbreak – Declared Over

Dear Residents, Family Members, and Staff:

We have managed to work through the latest “outbreak”. As of yesterday, at midnight we have successfully completed 10 consecutive days without any new positive cases. This means that Public Health has removed the outbreak status for Princess Gardens. Our independent care area will return to normal operations starting today.

In doing so, group activities, social gatherings, and general visits can commence once again. As a reminder, please ensure that you book your visit with the front desk. Masks are required to be worn for the duration of your visit including in residents’ suites.

This outbreak started with two resident cases and remained at those same two cases throughout. As communicated previously, one resident experienced relatively mild symptoms and the other remained asymptomatic. I want to commend staff for diligent IPAC practices to contain the spread of the virus – especially given the significant spread that the community has been experiencing recently.

Once again I would like to thank everyone for their patience and understanding as we navigate through these situations.

I can’t emphasize enough that, despite the Province loosening restrictions, COVID-19 continues to circulate in our community and is a risk to the elderly and those with compromised immune systems. **We must continue to be vigilant** and diligently practice all remaining COVID safety measures and precautions.
