Princess Gardens in Outbreak – Declared Over

Dear Residents, Family Members, and Staff:

I am happy to report that we have received final confirmation from Public Health that they are declaring the outbreak at Princess Gardens over.

We have not had any new resident cases since March 7th. The last reported staff case, which was determined to be community-acquired, was March 14th. All cases have been resolved.

So, this means that we will return to normal operations in the Enriched Care area again. Residents will be able to attend activities in our Independent Retirement areas if they would like. Those that attend meals in the main dining room can return again.

I would like to thank the entire staff here at Princess Gardens for all their efforts and dedication to ensuring the outbreak was contained and measures adhered to, to reduce the chance of further spread.

This outbreak is a good reminder that even as public mandates are being lifted, the virus is still spreading, so we will remain cautious to protect the well being of the residents and our staff.
