Princess Gardens in Outbreak Protocols - Update

Dear Residents, Family Members, and Staff:

On Monday March 7, 2022 we completed PCR testing for all residents and staff. In total 182 tests were processed. One additional enriched care resident tested positive, the balance of the residents and all staff showed negative results for COVID 19.

The resident was already on isolation due to the outbreak status in enriched care. This brings our positive case count to 4 residents, there has not been any staff cases identified. The 4 residents are all asymptomatic at this time.

In the Enriched Care area **only**, the following outbreak protocols remain in place:

- Cancellation of all general visits
- Cancellation of group programs and activities
- Residents are to remain in their rooms, with tray service for all meals
- Essential Care Visitors can still visit, but are limited to one visitor at a time, with additional PPE requirements

Visits to the rest of the building can continue per Public Health instructions. We continue to complete rapid antigen tests for visitors, contactors, and staff. All eligible residents have received their 4th vaccine dose, which should provide some additional protection. All of our staff are fully-vaccinated and those eligible have had their booster-shot.

We continue to collaborate with Peterborough Public Health, implementing all protocols as directed. We will inform you if/when circumstances change.
